

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on August 10, 2020, in the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA Hwy. 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll which resulted as follows:

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and carried to approve the minutes as written from the regular meeting on July 13, 2020.

**APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT**

A motion was made by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the treasurer's reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

**APPROVAL OF INVOICES**

A motion was made by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

**DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

***Police Report – Police Chief Landon Landry***

In July, 345 citations were issued with 20 warnings. Six traffic accidents/incidents were worked, three arrests were made, and 59 complaints were answered. Fines collected for the month were \$51,528.

The Chevrolet Tahoe K-9 unit was sold to Harahan Police Department for \$13,000.

***Water/Gas and Dangerous Structures - Council Member Greg Jarreau***

Two letters of noncompliance regarding junk were recently sent out.

***Grass Department – Council Member Terry Jarreau***

Several letters were sent to property owners in violation of the grass ordinance.

***Street Department – Council Member Warren Pourciau***

According to Parish Councilman Kurt Jarreau, David Street will be overlaid by the end of the year. There were problems with the contractor on the road rehabilitation contract.

The speed bumps were re-installed on Freneaux Street.

***Public Works and Utilities – Director Ricky David***

The department has been extremely busy locating utility lines due to fiber being installed.

**2020 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE – State Representative Jeremy LaCombe**

Representative LaCombe gave a brief update on several bills that passed during the legislative sessions this year. A bill that he introduced was passed regarding rural water districts with less than 1,250 customers. The bill allows those water systems exemption from the twenty-five percent match on the Capital Outlay Appropriations. He felt that another special session will be held to address the state revenue challenges due to COVID-19.

DOTD plans to overlay the remainder of US HWY 190 in Pointe Coupee Parish next year and there is hope that they will construct turn lanes at Bigman Lane.
