## **PROPOSED INCREASE IN WATER RATES – Council Member Greg Jarreau**

Mr. G. Jarreau stated that there has been no increase in the water rates since the water meters were installed in 2003. A proposal for a rate increase over 3 years with different options will be presented soon.

## **DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

### ***Police Report – Police Chief Landon Landry***

During the month of November, 506 violations were issued with 17 warnings. Forty-nine complaints were answered and 3 accidents/incidents were worked. Fines collected for the month were \$58,122.

### ***Water/Gas and Dangerous Structures – Council Member Greg Jarreau***

The annual gas leakage survey was recently completed on the gas system.

### ***Grass, Park, and Recreation – Council Member Terry Jarreau***

Two areas are in violation of the grass ordinance. One will be cut by the town.

### ***Sewer – Council Member Ron LeBlanc***

There were problems again with the floats on the main sewer lift station on LA 78. Will check into alarm options that will notify the town when there's a problem.

Livonia Mardi Gras has been canceled for 2021, due to Covid-19.
