

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
February 11, 2019
6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on February 11, 2019, in the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA Hwy. 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll which resulted as follows:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried to approve the minutes as written from the regular meeting on January 14, 2019.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

A motion was made by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. Pourciau, and carried, to approve the treasurer's report. Budget-to-actual was included in council meeting correspondence for review and comments.

APPROVAL OF INVOICES

A motion was made by Mr. Bergeron, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

STAR COMMUNICATIONS

On behalf of Star Communications, Mr. Charlie Moreau gave a presentation regarding the fiber optic and high speed internet coming to the Livonia and Fordoche areas. He encouraged everyone who may be interested in having high speed internet service to pre-register. By doing so it will enable Star Communications to know which areas are in the highest demand for this service.

RESOLUTION

A resolution was offered by Mr. Pourciau adopting the completed Systems Survey and Compliance Questionnaire as presented and to present a copy to Faulk & Winkler LLC for the 2018 audit. Mr. LeBlanc seconded the motion and the resolution passed.

GRANT WRITER CONTRACT

Council Member Ron LeBlanc made a motion to approve the revised contract by Ms. Janet Marionneaux for grant writing. Motion was seconded by Mr. Bergeron and carried.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Police Report –Police Chief Brad Joffrion

During the month of January, 343 citations were issued with 23 warning. Six arrests were made, 3 traffic accidents/incidents were worked, and 111 complaints were answered. Fines collected for the month were \$30,469.

Upon recommendation by Chief Joffrion, a motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to rehire Mr. Ned Tolliver as a part-time officer. Motion was seconded by Mr. Bergeron and carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Bergeron to declare four (4) 800mz mobile radios as surplus property since the police department no longer use the radios. Motion was seconded by Mr. Pourciau and carried.

Upon recommendation by Chief Joffrion, a motion was made by Mr. T. Jarreau to donate the 4 mobile radios mentioned above to Opelousas City Marshall's Office. Motion was seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau and carried.

Drainage and Abandoned Vehicles – Council Member James Bergeron

Will be flushing culverts and cleaning ditches soon.

Water, Gas, and Abandoned Buildings – Council Member Greg Jarreau

There were main water leaks and gas leaks last month. A bore was needed to repair a main water line leak.

Grass and Glaser's Park – Council Member Terry Jarreau

Mowing season has started early this year.

Many ball teams have been practicing at Glaser's Park. The batting cages are being utilized a great deal.

MAYOR'S REPORT

The speed bumps on LeBeau Street were destroyed by a trailer hauling equipment. Mayor advised to send a invoice to the owner of trailer after obtaining the cost to replace them.
