

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
February 19, 2020
6:00 p.m.**

A special meeting was called by Mayor Rhett Pourciau to discuss an option for recently hired full-time officer Jordan Cannon.

The Livonia Town Council met in special session at 6:00 p.m., in the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA Hwy. 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll. Roll call taken resulted as follows:

- PRESENT:** Council Members James Bergeron, Greg Jarreau, Terry Jarreau, Ron LeBlanc, and Warren Pourciau
ABSENT: None

Mayor Pourciau stated that after the regular council meeting on February 10, more research was done into the hiring of part-time Police Officer Jordan Cannon as full-time. It is Officer Cannon's desire to work a full-time shift only temporarily until a replacement is found. He recommended keeping Officer Cannon as part-time but at a full-time officer's salary of \$17.75 per hour, [\$15.00 per hour plus \$2.75 per hour which includes the amount she would get in supplemental pay if she was full-time] until a replacement is found.

A motion was made by Mr. Bergeron, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried to accept Mayor Pourciau's recommendation as stated above.
