

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
July 8, 2024 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on July 8, 2024, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call roll which resulted as follows:

THE FOLLOWING WERE APPROVED

MINUTES: Motion by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on June 10, 2024.

TREASURER’S REPORT: Motion by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

INVOICES: Motion by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

ADOPTION OF ACT 393 PROCEDURES RELATED TO OPEN MEETINGS

Mr. LeBlanc made a motion to adopt the rules presented for remote participation in Open Meetings by those with ADA-Recognized disabilities. Mr. T. Jarreau seconded the motion and was carried.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Mr. Gregg Gautreaux

Bids for the gas line improvements on Hobson Street will be presented at the next council meeting to be awarded.

A motion to approve the payment request of \$55,103.40 from JNGIII Construction, for the Water Sector water line improvement project was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and carried.

Police Report – Police Chief Landon Landry

In June, 450 citations were issued with 8 warnings. Three traffic accidents/incidents were worked, 2 arrests were made, and 46 complaints answered. Fines collected for the month were \$85,247.

Chief Landry stated as police chief he is happy with how far the department has come in the past four years. He announced he will be seeking re-election for another term this fall.

Each Council Member gave brief updates on their departments.

Council Members Greg Jarreau and Henry Watson stated that they were not seeking re-election as Council Members.

Council Member Ron LeBlanc reported the demolition of the condemned Jarreau property at 8813 Airline Highway will begin on July 9, 2024.

MAYOR’S REPORT – Mayor Rhett Pourciau

Mayor reminded everyone of “Warren Pourciau Day” being July 23rd.

Mayor Pourciau announced that he will be seeking re-election for the next term, also.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Messrs. Richard "Rich" Hirsch and Lorne "Man" Webre announced their candidacy for Town Council.
