

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
March 11, 2024 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on March 11, 2024, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call roll which resulted as follows:

THE FOLLOWING WERE APPROVED

MINUTES: Motion by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on February 12, 2024.

TREASURER’S REPORT: Motion by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

INVOICES: Motion by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

RESOLUTIONS

A resolution was offered by Mr. G. Jarreau to adopt the Pointe Coupee Parish Hazard Mitigation Updated 2023 Plan. Motion was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried.

A resolution was offered by Mr. T. Jarreau to adopt the 2023 Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Audit Report for the wastewater treatment plant permit. Motion was seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau and carried.

A resolution was offered by Mr. G. Jarreau to adopt the La. Compliance Questionnaire and present to Faulk & Winkler, CPA for 2023 Audit. Motion was seconded by Mr. Watson and carried.

INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to introduce an ordinance amending Section 17.29 of the Zoning Ordinance to rezone 2863 Maringouin Road East, from R1 (Residential) to R2A (Multiple Family Residential). The motion was seconded by Mr. Watson and carried. A public hearing will be held at the next regular council meeting.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Mr. Gregg Gautreaux

The advertisement for bids to repair the sewer plant problem was delayed because more time was needed for the screen additive alternate specifications.

Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry

In February 411 citations were issued with 11 warnings. Five traffic accidents/incidents were worked, 45 complaints were answered, and 1 arrest was made. Fines collected for the month were \$86,186.30.

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to accept Chief Landry’s recommendation to replace the flooring at PD2. Motion was seconded by Mr. Watson and carried.

Chief Landry recommended hiring Deputy Devon McNair to replace Officer Fred Gueho as a part-time police officer. Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to approve the recommendation which was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried.

Each Council Member gave brief updates on their departments.

In Council Member LeBlanc's absence, Mayor Pourciau addressed the agenda item regarding the recommendation to condemn property at 8813 Airline Hwy. Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to table the item until the town attorney could review what procedures were already done. Motion was seconded by Mr. Watson and carried.

Public Works and Utilities – Ricky David

Upon Mr. David's recommendation, Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to purchase a Kubota RTV utility vehicle. Mr. T. Jarreau seconded the motion and was carried.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried to adjourn the meeting at 7:48 p.m.
