

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
November 14, 2022 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on November 14, 2022, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll which resulted as follows:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on October 10, 2022.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER’S REPORT

A motion was made by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Ms. Pourciau, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

APPROVAL OF INVOICES

A motion was made by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

REQUEST TO SUBDIVIDE PROPERTY – Ms. Alex Gabor

A request was made by Ms. Gabor to void the previous request and approval made in October to subdivide Lot C on Steven Lane into Lots C-1 and C-2. A new request was made to subdivide the property into lots C-1, C-2, and C-3.

All subdivision of property requirements are being met therefore Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to approve the request as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried.

ZONING COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT

Upon the resignation of Mr. Jeremy Torres, a recommendation was made by the Zoning Chairman to appoint Mr. Lorne “Man” Webre to the Zoning Committee effective immediately.

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and unanimously carried to appoint Mr. Webre to fill the vacant position on the Zoning Committee.

WATER SECTOR PROGRAM PROJECT – Round 1

A letter was received from OCD-LGA stating that the town could be permitted to bid and construct the water line upgrades, per the contract, with the understanding that a water system rate study will be done and the town must take action to implement any needed changes to the rates. If the town approves this exception, a letter to that effect must be sent to OCD-LGA for final approval.

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and unanimously carried, to accept the water rate study exception and to send the letter for final approval to start bid and construction.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Mr. Gregg Gautreaux

DHH has approved the plans and spec to begin the water line improvement project along Tiger and Tena Streets. The contractor’s quotes are due by December 1, 2022, and will be presented to the council on December 12, 2022, for award consideration.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry

In October, 332 citations were issued with 4 warnings. Seventy complaints were answered, 1 arrest was made, and four accidents were worked. Fines collected for the month were \$64,109.

Each Council Member gave a brief update on their departments.

Mr. T. Jarreau reported the first phase of the canal drainage project near the cemetery has been completed.

Ms. Pourciau thanked Ms. Kathy Perriera, representative from Woodmen of the World, for the American Flags donated to the town and police department.

Mr. Watson reported that the chlorine controller at the sewer plant had to be replaced.
