

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
November 13, 2023 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on November 13, 2023, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call roll which resulted as follows:

**THE FOLLOWING WERE APPROVED**

**MINUTES:** Motion by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on October 9, 2023.

**TREASURER’S REPORT:** Motion by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Ms. Pourciau, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

**INVOICES:** Motion by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

**REQUEST FOR PAYMENT**

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to approve the request for payment of \$43,934.40 for water line improvements along LA HWY 78 by contractor JNGIII Construction. Motion was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried, contingent on the state water sector program’s approval.

**DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

***Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry***

In October, 320 citations were issued with 15 warnings. Two traffic accidents/incidents were worked and 49 complaints were answered. Fines collected for the month were \$94,359 of which \$36,865 of that amount was from handheld radar citation collections.

Trick-or-Treat went very well. There was more participation this year and positive feedback was received.

***Each Council Member gave brief updates on their departments.***

***Public Works and Utilities – Ricky David***

- The remaining water sector funds will be used to tie in all service lines to the new main water line and upgrade the water lines along Vallet Street and Thorpe Street.
- The town engineer, PEC, has specs and drawings completed to proceed with getting the sewer plant repaired. The request for bids will begin in early 2024.
- After the water line upgrade is completed, the town will begin the Vallet Street drainage project.
- DOTD has started its road overplay project on LA HWY 78.

**MAYOR’S REPORT**

Due to the cold weather, the annual Halloween Party-at-the-Park was moved inside the Livonia Community Center. Will continue to have this event inside the community center in future years.
