

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
October 9, 2023 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on October 9, 2023, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call roll which resulted as follows:

THE FOLLOWING WERE APPROVED

MINUTES: Motion by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Ms. Pourciau, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on September 11, 2023.

TREASURER’S REPORT: Motion by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

INVOICES: Motion by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. Watson, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

REQUEST TO CHANGE PROPERTY TO RENTAL

A request was made by Andrew and Stacey Chevevert to change their residential property at 8612 Bergeron Street to a rental property.

All requirements were made to change the property to rental, therefore, Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to grant the request. Motion was seconded by Ms. Pourciau and carried.

REQUEST FOR PAYMENT

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to approve the request for payment of \$63,865.74 for water line improvements along LA HWY 78 by contractor JNGIII Construction. Motion was seconded by Ms. Pourciau and approved, contingent on the state water sector program’s approval.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry

In September, 358 citations were issued with 25 warnings. Five traffic accidents/incidents were worked and 52 complaints were answered. Fines collected for the month were \$109,863 of which \$33,560 of that amount was from handheld radar citation collections.

An unexpected expense of \$9,762 for a new engine occurred last month for the LP& spare police unit. Will use this repaired unit to replace the LP5 full-time unit.

Each Council Member gave brief updates on their departments.
