

**LIVONIA TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
September 12, 2022 – 6:30 p.m.**

The Livonia Town Council met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. on September 12, 2022, at the Livonia Council Chambers, 3111 LA HWY 78, Livonia, Louisiana. Mayor Rhett Pourciau called the meeting to order and directed Town Clerk Donna Bergeron to call the roll which resulted as follows:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. LeBlanc, and carried to approve and publish the minutes as written from the regular meeting on August 8, 2022.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER’S REPORT

A motion was made by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Ms. Pourciau, and carried, to approve the treasurer’s reports. Budget-to-actual was included for review and comments.

APPROVAL OF INVOICES

A motion was made by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and carried, to approve the invoices for payment.

RESOLUTIONS

A resolution was offered by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. Watson, and Resolved, in support of the preparation and submittal of an application for funding through the Community Water Enhancement Fund.

A resolution was offered by Mr. T. Jarreau, seconded by Mr. G. Jarreau, and Resolved, in support of the preparation and submittal of an application for funding through the Local Government Assistance Program.

REQUEST TO CHANGE PROPERTY TO RENTAL

A request was made by Ms. Stacy Guillory Chenevert to change the property at 8628 Bergeron Street to rental property. Written consent from all adjacent property owners was submitted.

Mr. G. Jarreau made a motion to approve Ms. Chenevert’s request, which was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau, and carried.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Police Report –Police Chief Landon Landry

In August, 570 citations were issued with 7 warnings. Forty-three complaints were answered and three accidents were worked. Fines collected for the month were \$65,500.

- Upon recommendation by Chief Landry, a motion was made by Mr. G. Jarreau to hire Mr. Timothy Jarreau as a part-time laborer for his department at \$15 per hour. Mr. Jarreau would assist with the installation and repairs of radios and police equipment when needed. Motion was seconded by Mr. T. Jarreau and carried.

Each Council Member gave a brief update on their departments.

Trick-or-Treat will be held on October 31 from 6:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. throughout the town and at Glaser's Park.

Mr. Steve Morgan, 8732 Glaser Street, asked the town to clean out the culverts from 8702 Glaser north to Monica Street or further to the canal to allow better drainage.
